BACKGROUND

Social media is omnipresent. Through it, we gain easy, almost unfiltered access to a nearly infinite array of information from every corner of the globe, including crisis and war zones, which—thanks to algorithms—appear on our small or large screens. Social media can serve as a source of independent information, thus contributing to informing individuals and societies. However, it is also utilized to disseminate fake news manipulate public opinion, or even incite violence. Conflict parties intentionally sow doubt and foster discord, spread by algorithms and bots that exert influence beyond the digital realm. In autocratic regimes, social media is often not only a symbol of freedom, but also a tool of oppression. The rapid development of artificial intelligence will further exacerbate this issue. "Deep fakes"—realistic forgeries—have already become a part of our daily lives and are a popular tool in the information war.

In this context, we aim to discuss how social media and artificial intelligence influence our perception of wars and conflicts, the role of fake news and disinformation campaigns, and the roles traditional media should play. How can we critically and responsibly manage the flood of information without becoming victims of new forms of warfare?
